The following list should be consulted whenever the Typikon directs that seasonal katavasiae be chanted with the Canon(s) at Orthros (*e.g.*, all Sundays, feasts of the Master and of the Mother of God, Vigil, Polyeleos, and Doxology commemoration of Saints). The page numbers refer to Hieromonk Seraphim Nassar's Divine Prayers and Services.
